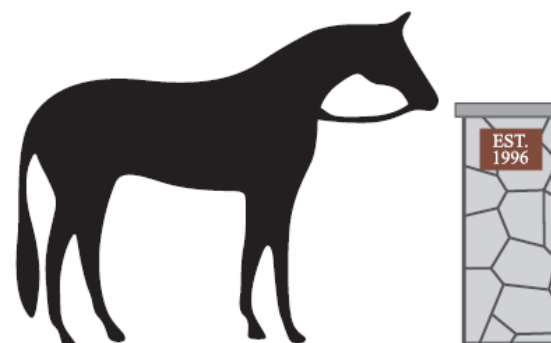

Directions to Stonehouse Stables:

From North West (Richmond) - take I-64 East to Exit 227. Bear Right on Route 30. At first stoplight Route 30 turns into Route 60. Go straight. Approx. 2 miles, turn right on Route 610 (Forge Road) as you enter Toano. Fire Station visible at turn. Go 2.3 miles. Stonehouse Stables is on the right. Look for the sign.

From South East (Williamsburg) – Take I-64 West to exit 231-A. Turn right on Route 60 west. Turn left, at Fire Station, on to Forge Rd (Route 610). Go 2.3 miles. Stonehouse Stables is on the right. Look for the sign.

Rules and Regulations:

1. All shows are members of CHSA and Associate members of VHSA.
2. Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes. Division champions receive a prize and ribbon & reserve champions receive a ribbon. Points will count towards annual high score awards. Classes with fewer than six entries may be combined at management's discretion.
3. Hard hats are required at all times when mounted. **All riders must wear an approved helmet at all times.**
4. A horse/ pony must have been entered in at least one class over fences in a division to be eligible for the under saddle class and must be in the top 4 over fences to be eligible for the Champion or Reserve Champion.
5. **A Negative Coggins is required for all animals on the grounds and a copy must be provided to show secretary.**
6. This show is run in accordance with the ground rules of the VHSA, with the exception of fence heights.
7. Any talking to the judge is prohibited. The judge's placing is final.
8. Stonehouse Stables reserves the right to refuse any entry; to change the time schedule; to combine classes; or change judges at any time.
10. A rider's age is defined by their age as of December 1, 2019.
11. Stonehouse Stables will not be responsible for accidents or loss of property.
12. All dogs must be leashed.
13. No stallions permitted on grounds.
14. All riding is done at your own risk according to VA Equine law & all persons on the property are considered participants or spectators. Anyone not wishing to be a participant or spectator must view the show from the office lounge.
15. A \$25 billing fee will be charged for unpaid show tabs and returned checks

Division Specifications:

- **CHSA Short Stirrup Hunter:** Open to Juniors who have not reached their 13th Birthday by 12/1/2016. Judged as a Hunter Division. Riders may cross enter into Pleasure only. Fences 18”.
- **SCHOOLING HUNTER:** Horses or Ponies ridden by adults. Cross entering is permitted. Fences 2’6”, 2’9”. No jog.
- **JUNIOR AMATEUR SCHOOLING:** To be ridden by a junior or an Amateur. Horses only. Cross entering is permitted. Fences are 2’6” or 2’9”. The two heights are judged together. No Jog.
- **OPEN HUNTER:** Open to all horses. Fences are 3’ or 3’3”. The two heights are judged together.
- **GREEN HUNTER:** Limited to horses in their first or second year of showing over 2’ 9” fences at any show, including equitation classes, connected with an Annual High Score Award. First year horses jump 2’9”. Second year horses jump 3’. All heights are judged together.
- **CHILDREN’S HUNTER:** Open only to junior riders. Horses only. Fences 2’9” or 3’. The two heights are to be judged together.
- **ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER:** To be ridden by an Amateur who is no longer eligible to compete as a junior. Leased horses are permitted. Fences are 2’ 9” or 3’. The two heights are judged together.
- **ADULT AMATEUR PLEASURE HORSE:** Three classes must be offered. Two classes at the “walk, trot, canter”. One class at the “walk and go as you please”. Open only to non-junior riders. No cross-entering between this and junior Hunter Pleasure Horse at the same show.
- **JUNIOR HUNTER PLEASURE HORSE:** Three classes must be offered. Two classes at the “walk, trot, canter”. One class at the “walk and go as you please”. Open to only junior riders. No cross-entering between this and Adult Hunter Pleasure Horse at the same show.
- **CHSA CHILDREN/ADULT AMATEUR EQUITATION:** Children or Adult Amateurs on horses. Riders may cross-enter into Pleasure but not into any regular horse division or CHSA equitation classes. Single equitation class over fences with a flat phase. Fences are 2’ or 2’6”. The two heights are judged together.
- **CHILDREN’S/ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER:** Children or Adult Amateurs on horses. Riders may cross-enter into Pleasure but not into any regular horse division or CHSA equitation classes. Fences are 2’ or 2’6”. The two heights are judged together. No Jog.
- **SPECIAL HUNTERS:** Open to horses and ponies. Open to all riders and horse/pony combinations. Fences are 2’ and 2’6”. The two heights are judged together. No jog.
- **CHSA SHORT STIRRUP:** Open to Juniors who have not reached their 13th birthday as of December 1, 2015. To be judged as an **equitation** division. The Champion and Reserve must have completed the course in at least one jumping class. The division will consist of four classes, a walk/trot, a walk/trot/canter, and two jumping four 18” fences. The rider may cross enter only into pleasure classes at the show. The pony may cross enter. Should there be 18 or more entries the division shall be split into two separate divisions. Additionally, no more than 10 entries may canter at the same time.
- **CHSA PONY EQUITATION:** Juniors only. (Small 2’, medium 2’3”, large 2’6”). Selected riders may be required to return and hack. No cross-entering between this and Junior equitation at the same show.
- **CHSA ADULT EQUITATION:** Adults only. (fences 2’9”, 3’) Selected riders may be required to return and hack.
- **CHSA JUNIOR EQUITATION:** Juniors only. (fences 2’9”, 3’) Selected riders may be required to return and hack. No cross-entering between this and Pony equitation at the same show.
- **GREEN PONY HUNTER:** fences are (Large 2’6”, Medium 2’3”, small 2’). Juniors only. Open to ponies that have not shown over fences at these heights prior to December 1, 2015 at any show connected with an annual high score award; except Small may have shown in one prior year over 2’ fences at a show connected with an annual high score award. This division may combine with regular pony division or the Green Hunter Division if the Green Hunter Division has not been combined with the Open Hunter Division.
- **SMALL-MEDIUM PONY HUNTER:** Juniors only. Fences are (Small 2’, Medium 2’3”) If both sections (Small and Medium) reach 12 entries, the division will be split and points will be awarded in each section.
- **LARGE PONY HUNTERS:** Juniors only. Fences are 2’6” or 2’9”.
- **HUNTER PLEASURE PONY:** Juniors only. Three classes must be offered. Two classes at the “walk, trot, canter” and one class at the “walk and go as you please”.
- **CHSA CHILDRENS PONY EQUITATION:** Children on ponies. Riders may cross-enter into Pleasure or Special Hunters but not into any regular pony divisions or other equitation classes. Single equitation class over fences with a flat phase. Fences are 2’ or 2’6”. The two heights are judged together. (Showing in this division will disqualify a pony for future green pony status)
- **CHILDRENS PONY HUNTER:** Children on ponies .Riders may cross-enter into Pleasure or Special Hunters but not into any regular pony divisions or CHSA equitation classes. Fences are 2’ or 2’6”. The two heights are judged together. (WARNING- Showing in this division will disqualify pony for future green pony status) No Jog.
- **THOROUGHBRED HUNTER:** Thoroughbred Hunter is limited to horses who are registered with or are eligible to be registered with the Jockey Club. Fences 2’6” and 2’9”.
- **CHSA/VHSA Adult Equitation on the Flat:** Open to amateurs 18 years of age and older.
- **CHSA/VHSA/CHSA Junior Equitation on the Flat 15-17:** Open to riders who have reached their 15 birthday by December 1st of the calendar year, but not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st
- **CHSA/VHSA Junior Equitation on the Flat 14 & Under.** Open to riders who have not reached their 15th birthday by December 1st of the calendar year.

Stonehouse Stables, Inc. COVID-19 Protocols & Entry Procedures

We are excited to start showing again and are planning to provide as safe an environment for our participants and staff as possible. We ask that everyone planning to attend the show reads the following prior to arrival and adheres to these policies throughout the show.

Entry to the Facility

- Only show staff, trainers, riders, guardians of minors, and essential support personnel may attend the show. We ask that you limit the number of essential staff and family members to the greatest degree possible.

No spectators are permitted.

- We ask that all participants please take their temperature before coming out to the show grounds. Anyone with a temperature below 99.5 is permitted on premises.

If you are having any symptom of illness such as headache, stomach-ache, coughing, excessive sneezing, runny nose, aches, or are generally not feeling well, please stay home. • Anyone currently exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms, who has tested positive or has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the 14 days prior to arriving at the grounds should not attend the event.

- Anyone who becomes ill during the event will be directed to the appropriate local healthcare provider and will not be permitted back onto the grounds. Face Masks & PPE • Facemasks are required when there is a possibility of being within 6 feet of another person, except when mounted. Individuals who have an ADA accommodation permitting the absence of a face mask should provide a copy to management.
- Communal property such as bathroom doors, will be disinfected however gloves are recommended for additional protection.
- Hand Sanitizer will be at both rings and schooling rings for coaches to use before handling jump cups in the schooling rings. Glove are recommended.
 - Individuals are encouraged to bring their own hand sanitizer for personal use.
- It is the trainer's responsibility to provide necessary PPE to their own staff/clients and to disinfect their own property (golf carts, hoses, etc) that another individual might come into contact with.

Social Distancing

 - Social distancing of 6 feet apart should be observed everywhere on the show grounds. Group gatherings even amongst barns will be monitored and will be asked to disperse.
- In the event of inclement weather exhibitors should shelter in their vehicles do not crowd into the stable area.

Food & Beverage

- We will have **NOT** have a traditional food vendor onsite and will notify attendees prior to the event if this plan changes so attendees can plan accordingly.

Staff Interactions

- Please be respectful of our hard-working staff who will all be working to keep the show a safe and pleasant experience for everyone.
 - All staff will be provided with PPE and will be familiarized with the COVID protocols for the facility. If a member of staff requests, you observe a protocol please use common courtesy and comply. Any issues should be brought to management's attention.

- Please be mindful of distance near in-gate booths and try to conduct any business in a timely manner. **Orders of go WILL BE SET BY TRAINER and HEIGHT** please be sure to enter with heights.

- Courses will be handed out with your numbers and copies will be available to help reduce crowding at the in-gate.

Friday Schooling Rings will be limited to 10 or less horses at one time. Schooling will be available for \$25 from 10am-5:30pm on Friday for both rings.

Entry Procedures

- Entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis and will be capped at capacity. No day of adds to the show. Scratches accepted prior to the start of the division.
- All entries must be in no later than Thursday prior to the show. Entries accepted via email or fax. If coggins are uploaded to the CHSA site, you do not need to provide a copy. If you are not a member you must email or fax a copy to have entry accepted.

- Stalls are limited in order to space out groups.

- The show office will conduct business but limit the number of people as posted. No one is allowed up at the announcer booth or the Judges booth at any time.

Payment will be by cash, check or Venmo only. We are unable to accept credit cards at this time.
