\*\*Pre Entries must be mailed, e-mailed or sent online and include a copy of your Coggins or post entry fee will apply. This show is open to all competitors. It is a member show of the CHSA and a VHSA Associate Show. The show will be run in accordance with the VHSA rules with the exception of fence heights. Six ribbons will be awarded in each class. A championship and reserve ribbon will be awarded in each division. A horse or pony must have shown in at least one fences class to be eligible for the under saddle class of that division. A negative Coggins test is required for all horses and ponies on the show grounds. **All exhibitors must wear an ASTM/SEI approved helmets at all times when mounted.** Junior riders must be supervised by an adult at all times. All owners and riders must sign a waiver of liability stating that Stillmeadows Farm will not be responsible for any accident loss or damage. An adult must sign for all juniors. Show Manager reserves the right to refuse entry, to change the schedule, to combine classes and to change the judge at any time.

\*\* The Stillmeadows Classic will now be offered for all heights in ring 1. **\$500 Stillmeadows Classic:** The Stillmeadows Classic will be run as a two round Classic. The first round will be the second over fences trip of the Thoroughbred, Schooling, Jr/Am Schooling, Open, Green, Adult Amateur and Children's Hunter division. You must declare to the starter if you are doing the Classic before you enter the ring for your Classic Round. The Handy course may be jumped during the division in which you jump the Classic round. The second round of the Classic will be a Handy Round. Numerical scores will be given in both rounds. **WARMUP: Each horse and rider combination may participate in ONE warm-up class at each horse show. Cost is \$20.**

## DIVISION SPECIFICATIONS

- **SCHOOLING HUNTER:** Horses or Ponies ridden by adults. Cross entering is permitted. Fences 2'6", 2'9". No jog.
- **JUNIOR AMATEUR SCHOOLING:** To be ridden by a junior or an Amateur. Horses only. Cross entering is permitted. Fences are 2'6" or 2'9". The two heights are judged together. No Jog.
- **OPEN HUNTER:** Open to all horses. Fences are 2'9 and 3' judged together, JOG
- **GREEN HUNTER:** Limited to horses in their first or second year of showing over 2' 9" fences at any show, including equitation classes, connected with an Annual High Score Award. First year horses jump 2'9". Second year horses jump 3'. All heights are judged together. JOG
- **CHILDREN'S HUNTER:** Open only to junior riders. Horses only. Fences 2'9" or 3' The heights are to be judged together. JOG
- **ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER:** To be ridden by an Amateur who is no longer eligible to compete as a junior. Leased horses are permitted. Fences are 2' 9" and 3' The heights are judged together. JOG
- **ADULT PLEASURE HORSE:** Three classes must be offered. Two classes at the "walk, trot, canter". One class at the "walk and go as you please". Open only to non-junior riders. No cross-entering between this and junior Hunter Pleasure Horse at the same show.
- **JUNIOR HUNTER PLEASURE HORSE:** Three classes must be offered. Two classes at the "walk, trot, canter". One class at the "walk and go as you please". Open to only junior riders. No cross-entering between this and Adult Hunter Pleasure Horse at the same show.
- **CHILDREN/ADULT AMATEUR EQUITATION:** Children or Adult Amateurs on horses. cross entering rules are the same as Children/Adult hunter (Fences are 2' or 2'6) Selected riders may be required to return and hack
- **CHILDREN'S/ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER:** Children or Adult Amateurs on horses. Riders may cross-enter into Pleasure but not into any regular horse division or CHSA equitation classes. Fences are 2' or 2'6". The two heights are judged together. No Jog.
- **SPECIAL HUNTERS:** Open to horses and ponies. Open to all riders and horse/pony combinations. Fences are 2' and 2'6". The two heights are judged together. No jog.
- **CHSA SHORT STIRRUP:** Open to Juniors who have not reached their 13th birthday as of December 1, 2015. To be judged as an equitation division. The Champion and Reserve must have completed the course in at least one jumping class. The division will consist of four classes, a walk/trot, a walk/trot/canter, and two jumping four 18" fences. The rider may cross enter only into pleasure classes at the show. The pony may cross enter. Should there be 18 or more entries the division shall be split into two separate divisions. Additionally, no more than 10 entries may canter at the same time.
- **CHSA/VHSA SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER:** Open to horses and ponies ridden by Juniors who have not reached their 13th birthday as of December 1, 2016, the division will consist of three (3) classes, two over fence classes at "18 and a walk, trot, canter under saddle class. Short Stirrup riders, ponies and horses may not cross enter into any other VHSA Associate Division or a VHSA Associate rated Equitation Class with the exception of VHSA Associate Junior Equitation On The Flat and Pleasure Pony or Pleasure Horse at any show in which they exhibit in the Short Stirrup Division . The Short Stirrup division cannot be combined with any other VHSA Associate High Score Award Division.
- **CHSA PONY EQUITATION:** Juniors only. (Small 2', medium 2'3", large 2'6"). Selected riders may be required to return and hack. No cross entering between this and Junior equitation at the same show.
- **CHSA ADULT EQUITATION:** Adults only. (fences 2'9", 3') Selected riders may be required to return and hack.
- **CHSA JUNIOR EQUITATION:** Juniors only. (fences 2'9", 3') Selected riders may be required to return and hack. No cross-entering between this and Pony equitation at the same show.
- **GREEN PONY HUNTER:** fences are (Large 2'6", Medium 2'3", small 2'). Juniors only. Open to ponies that have not shown over fences at these heights prior to December 1, 2015 at any show connected with an annual high score award; except Small may have shown in one prior year over 2' fences at a show connected with an annual high score award. This division may combine with regular pony division or the Green Hunter Division if the Green Hunter Division has not been combined with the Open Hunter Division. JOG
- **SMALL-MEDIUM PONY HUNTER:** Juniors only. Fences are ( Small 2', Medium 2'3") If both sections ( Small and Medium) reach 12 entries, the division will be split and points will be awarded in each section JOG.

- LARGE PONY HUNTERS: Juniors only. Fences are 2'6" or 2'9". JOG
  - HUNTER PLEASURE PONY: Juniors only. Three classes must be offered. Two classes at the "walk, trot, canter" and one class at the "walk and go as you please".
  - CHILDRENS PONY EQUITATION: Children on ponies. cross entering rules are the same as Children's Pony (Fences are 2' or 2'6) Selected riders may be required to return and hack
  - CHILDREN'S PONY HUNTER: Children on ponies Riders may cross-enter into Pleasure or Special Hunters but not into any regular pony divisions or CHSA equitation classes. Fences are 2' or 2'6". The two heights are judged together. (WARNING- Showing in this division will disqualify pony for future green pony status) No Jog.
  - THOROUGHBRED HUNTER: Thoroughbred Hunter is limited to horses who are registered with or are eligible to be registered with the Jockey Club. Fences 2'6" and 2'9".
  - CHSA/VHSA Adult Equitation on the Flat: Open to amateurs 18 years of age and older.
  - CHSA/VHSA Junior Equitation on the Flat 15-17: Open to riders who have reached their 15 birthday by December 1st of the calendar year, but not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st
  - CHSA/VHSA Junior Equitation on the Flat 14 & Under. Open to riders who have not reached their 15th birthday by December 1st of the calendar year.
- California Warm - UP** – Not Judged. Each horse and Rider combination may participate in ONE warm-up class at each show. At management's discretion, this class may be discontinued at any time. You must let the starter know before you enter the ring if you are participating in the warmup. **YOU MUST JUMP COURSE**

## **COVID-19 Warning**

**We have taken enhanced health and safety measures—for you, our other exhibitors, and Staff. You must follow all posted instructions while on these show grounds.**

## **COVID-19 Protocols & Entry Procedures**

### **Entry to the Facility**

- Only show staff, trainers, riders, guardians of minors (please limit to 2 parents/guardians), and essential support personnel may attend the show. We ask that you limit the number of essential staff and family members to the greatest degree possible. This show is not open to the public.
  - When possible, we ask that exhibitors arrive no more than 1 hour prior to their classes, and plan to leave promptly after riding. Results will be announced and ribbons will be available for pick up.
- We ask that all participants please take their temperature before coming out to the show grounds. Anyone with a temperature below 99.5 is permitted on premises.
  - If you are having any symptom of illness such as headache, stomach-ache, coughing, excessive sneezing, runny nose, aches, or are generally not feeling well, please stay home.

- Anyone currently exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms, who has tested positive or has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the 14 days prior to arriving at the grounds should not attend the event.
- Anyone who becomes ill during the event will be directed to the appropriate local healthcare provider and will not be permitted back onto the grounds.

### **Face Masks & PPE**

- Facemasks are required when there is a possibility of being within 6 feet of another person, except when mounted. Individuals who have an ADA accommodation permitting the absence of a face mask should provide a copy to management.
- Communal property such as bathroom doors, will be disinfected; however, gloves are recommended for additional protection.
- Hand Sanitizer will be at both rings and schooling rings for coaches to use before handling jump cups in the schooling rings. Glove are recommended.
- Individuals are encouraged to bring their own hand sanitizer for personal use.
- It is the trainer's responsibility to provide necessary PPE to their own staff/clients and to disinfect their own property (golf carts, hoses, etc) that another individual might come into contact with.

### **Social Distancing**

- Social distancing of 6 feet apart should be observed everywhere on the show grounds. Group gatherings even amongst barns will be monitored and will be asked to disperse.
- In the event of inclement weather exhibitors should shelter in their vehicles not crowd into the stable area.

### **Food & Beverage**

- We will have a traditional food vendor onsite and will notify attendees prior to the event if this plan changes so attendees can plan accordingly.



### **Staff Interactions**

- Please be respectful of our hard-working staff who will all be working to keep the show a safe and pleasant experience for everyone.
- All staff will be provided with PPE and will be familiarized with the COVID protocols for the facility. If a member of staff requests you observe a protocol please use common courtesy and comply. Any issues should be brought to management's attention.
- Please be mindful of distance near in-gate booths and try to conduct any business in a timely manner. Orders of go will be set and emailed out Friday evening.
- Courses will be emailed out Friday evening and copies will be handed out with your numbers and will be available to help reduce crowding at the in-gate.

### **Friday Schooling**

- Rings will be limited to 10 or less horses at one time. Schooling will be available for \$25 from 10am-5:30pm on Friday for both rings

### **Entry Procedures**

- Entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis.
- All entries must be in no later than **WEDNESDAY** prior to the show. We will not permit post entries. Please include your trainer and jump height so that orders of go can be set accordingly.
- Stalls are very limited, and will be available on a first come first serve basis.
- Due to the limited space inside the show office, no one will be permitted inside. No one is allowed up at the announcer booths or the Judges booths at any time.

Payment will be by cash, check or Venmo only. We are unable to accept credit cards at this time.
